




Welcome & Methodology

Welcome to the Top 100 Vertical Market MSPs[™] 2022 Edition. The research and corresponding list are based on a worldwide survey of MSPs, conducted in Q4 2021 through January 2022. Rankings are based on annual recurring revenues in specific vertical markets for fiscal year 2021. This is our seventh-annual research report.

The results reveal that the best vertical market MSPs easily grew faster than overall U.S. small business IT spending in 2021. Among the comparative data points to note:

- U.S. SMB IT spending (including products and services) grew 7.6% in 2021 over 2020, according to Techaisle.
- U.S. SMB IT services spending (excluding one-time product sales) grew 8.6% driven by managed services, data/platform integration, cloud orchestration, and business process automation, Techaisle found.
- In contrast, the Top 100 Vertical Market MSPs for 2022 increased their revenue 42% on average in 2021 vs. 2020, according to ChannelE2E. That growth (roughly 17 points higher than usual) reflects heavy M&A activity coupled with snap-back 2021 spending after the initial coronavirus-related business pressures in 2020.


Participating MSPs: Primary Vertical Market Focus Areas



♥ Instead of consolidating into fewer vertical markets, MSPs diversified their vertical market focus in order to minimize risks from any one vertical sector. The biggest vertical market gainer was manufacturing (up 5 points). Among the likely reasons: MSPs are helping manufacturers to automate and safeguard supply chains. Healthcare dipped (down 7 points) as the initial pandemicrelated IT boom eased a bit.

Combined Vertical Market Recurring Revenues*




The 100 MSPs lifted combined revenues in their top verticals to \$3.05 billion, up roughly 42% from last year's research. The larger-than-usual boost likely involved:


- 1. The U.S. economy, which witnessed accelerated IT spending in 2021 vs. 2020 as businesses adjusted to the "new extended normal" of COVID-19.
- **2.** MSPs doubled down on the manufacturing vertical, where customers spent heavily to navigate supply chain and cybersecurity business pressures.
- 3. M&A deals, often backed by private equity firms, continued to unite several vertical market MSPs.

Forty-nine of this year's Top 100 honorees also appeared on last year's list. That is lower than last year's repeat honoree count (59). The dip in repeat honorees reflects a larger base of MSPs participating in the survey, coupled with previous honorees that have been acquired.





Market Snapshot

Global enterprise IT spending in the banking and investment services market grew 7.1% to \$596 billion in 2021 vs. 2020, Garner found. IT spending is expected to generate a 6.5% compound annual growth rate (CAGR) through 2025, Gartner forecast. The five biggest IT trends in banking remain mobile, cloud, AI/ machine learning, blockchain and overall CX (customer experience), according to Bernard Marr & Co. Still, U.S. commercial banks could suffer up to \$254 billion of net loan losses from 2020 through the end of 2022, Deloitte predicts. Amid that backdrop, the banking industry will blend cost reduction strategies and business growth initiatives, Deloitte asserts. The other major unknown, as of this writing, involves Russia's invasion of Ukraine – and the associated financial market implications worldwide.

Market Snapshot

The Digital Health Market is expected to reach \$430.52 billion by 2028, generating a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 16.9% during the forecast period, according to Vantage Market Research. Meanwhile, healthcare IT spending grew 7.3% in 2021 to reach \$124 billion, Gartner said. Healthcare providers remain focused on digital transformation leading to investments in software and IT services associated with cybersecurity, data analytics and virtual care, Gartner added.

Marketing Snapshot

Spending on digital transformation in the manufacturing market will reach \$767.82 billion by 2026, which represents a 19.5% CAGR from 2021, Modor Intelligence forecasts. Focus areas for increased spending span Robotics, the Internet of Things, 3D Printing, Additive Manufacturing and Cybersecurity. Major technology partners include Cisco, Microsoft, Intel, IBM and Siemens AG, the Modor study found.

Market Snapshot

Law firms increased their technology spend by 7.1% during the 12-month period through November 2021, according to Thomson Reuters. In particular, legal firms spent more rigorously on IT systems that can manage and automate timekeeping, billings and collections. Also, spending on knowledge management and library services rose 4.6%, the survey found. Roughly 86% of lawyers now want to work remotely at least one day per week – which is double the figure from pre-pandemic levels.

Market Snapshot

Worldwide government IT spending will likely reach \$557.3 billion in 2022, up 6.5% from 2021, Gartner predicts. Spending on software (up 12%) and IT services (up 8.4%) will lead the market forward. Some of the growth involves the American Rescue Plan Act of March 2021 and NextGenEU – both of which will fuel IT funding on sustainable growth, social programs, education, cybersecurity, and digital inclusion, Gartner found.
